WASHINGTON ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

Students—you are about to become a Washington alumnus. If you are proud of your school, teachers, coaches and classmates, this scholarship may be just right for you. The Washington High School FiftyPlus Club has established a scholarship program to assist graduating senior students from Washington Technology Magnet School achieve their career goals and objectives.

Washington Alumni Scholarship awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability, national origin or financial need.

Two awards each in the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) are designed to reward students who have displayed during their high school years a strong support of the school and classmates. Award winners will be students who have shown leadership by donating time and effort into building school spirit through participation in various groups, activities, student government and sports, etc.

THE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA FOR APPLICANTS:

Be high school seniors who will be completing graduation requirements and plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two or four year college, university, or vocational-technical school in the United States for the entire upcoming academic year.

Have a minimum unweighted grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Have participated in many school activities while attending Washington Technology Magnet School. Activities include athletics, student government, organizations, clubs, productions, presentations, performances and other extracurricular school activities.

Have a history of exhibiting a positive commitment to Washington Technology Magnet School.

Have displayed a loyalty to and constructive impact on their graduating class.

Show excellent WTMS spirit by volunteering time and skills outside of school.

Plan to continue to stay involved with their graduating class as an alumnus.

THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a one-time \$4,000 award.

Awards are provided for the recipients' education and related expenses to aid them in obtaining the necessary educational skills to help achieve career goals and objectives. Related expenses include tuition, books and mandatory fees from schools. Not included are such things as rent, utility payments, travel expense, or repayment of student loans.

THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS:

By March 31, interested students must complete the application and turn in a Scholarship Application Packet to the 12th Grade Counselor in the College Center.

All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Washington Technology Magnet School Staff and the Washington High School FiftyPlus Club Scholarship Committee.

The Scholarship Application Packet consists of the following materials and must all be completed to be eligible for review:

1. *Scholarship Application Form*

2. *Official Transcript*

3. *Personal Essay*

In less than 250 words, explain why Washington Technology Magnet School and your graduating classmates are important to you.

4. *Two Letters of Recommendation*

SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS:

By April 15, Washington Technology Magnet School Staff will screen all applications and recommend four (4) applicants as scholarship finalists. Scholarship finalists are selected on the basis of demonstrated leadership, participation in school and community activities, academic record, statement of goals, and two letters of recommendation.

The Washington High School FiftyPlus Club Scholarship Committee will notify each scholarship finalist by email and phone using contact information given by the entrant during the application process.

By April 30, the Washington High School FiftyPlus Club Scholarship Committee, which makes the ultimate selection of scholarship winners, will schedule and hold individual interviews with the scholarship finalists at Washington Technology Magnet School.

By April 30, any applicant who has not been notified that they are a finalist for a scholarship award should understand that their request for assistance, while considered, was not granted.

By May 15, the Washington High School FiftyPlus Club Scholarship Committee will notify all scholarship finalist applicants of award determinations. Not all final applicants to the program will be selected as scholarship recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

By July 31, students selected as winners are required to submit the name and contact information of their chosen college/university/certified vocational-technical school to the Co-Chairs of the Selection Committee for verification of registration. If not provided by then, your scholarship may be forfeited.
